Victorian Planning Authority Projects Standing Advisory Committee Referral 12: Melton East Precinct Structure Plan

As advised in the Committee's letter of 12 June 2025, the Hearing Timetable has been adjusted to account for the expected timing of Transport and ICP conclaves and further advice regarding evidence to be called. Broadly, the changes include the following:

- Evidence on transport will now be heard from Tuesday 15 July to Thursday 17 July 2025
- Evidence on community infrastructure will now be heard on Friday 18 July 2025 which was previously a reserve day
- Evidence on ICPs and staging and infrastructure will now be allocated two full days on Monday 21 and Tuesday 22 July 2025
- The removal of Robert Luhan and Richard Luhan from the Timetable as requested.

The Hearing will be held primarily at 500 Bourke Street, Melbourne except for 11 (reserve day), 21, 22 and 23 July 2025 when it will be held at Planning Panels Victoria, 1 Spring Street, Melbourne.

Given the extensive number of experts to be called by parties the Committee will be issuing further directions regarding the provision of evidence in chief and cross examination to ensure an efficient hearing. It will also ensure that sufficient time is available for party submissions noting the range of advocate date limitations that the Committee has endeavoured to accommodate. These are likely to include:

- A time limit for evidence in chief of around 20 minutes (other than VPA experts limit of 30 minutes)
- Evidence in chief to be focused on the specific Table 1 theme issues and where conclaves have been conducted limited to matters of disagreement
- Cross examination to be limited to around 30 minutes or less depending on the complexity of the
 issue and be limited to matters associated with the Table 1 theme issues. Advocates other than
 for VPA/Melbourne Water/Melton City Council will be encouraged to identify lead crossexaminers for each theme issue
- Cross-examination to be largely confined to parties calling like evidence unless time permits clarification questions from other parties.


